NAVA 43 Details: 9-11 October 2009 Charleston, South Carolina

HOST HOTEL NAVA 43's host hotel, Embassy Suites Charleston—Historic Charleston, is located in the original Citadel Military College building. The grandly-restored facility is conveniently located near many downtown Charleston attractions, including some of the main flag-related sites NAVA 43 attendees will tour. A block of suites has been reserved through 9 August 2009 for the nights of 9/10/11 October. The rate is \$179/night plus tax for the two-room suites—and includes the complimentary breakfasts and evening receptions. Other nights before/after the meeting are at the same rate while available. Make sure to reserve before 9 August 2009, or space at the hotel cannot be guaranteed. To offset the higher-than-usual room rates, we have lowered the registration fee. TOURS On Saturday afternoon NAVA 43 expects to tour several fine sites on the Museum Mile in historic Charleston: the Charleston Museum, the Washington Light Infantry Armory, the Confederate Museum, and the South Carolina Historical Society. These institutions plan special welcomes including displays of their important and extensive flag collections. They are all on Meeting Street within walking distance of the hotel and on the #211 trolley line. Optional tour opportunities will include: a guided tour of the museum at the Citadel Military College, capped off by the dress parade of the corps of cadets (Friday afternoon) and a public tour of Fort Sumter (3 times daily).
